GFGS membership is open to all residents of the two villages. We have over 150 members. Approximately 9 golfing events are held throughout the year, with a similar number of social occasions.



Your Personal Data and Goldsborough & Flaxby Golfing Society (GFGS)

Personal information supplied by you to GFGS will be kept on file and stored securely. The data will be deleted once no longer relevant. Paper copies of Membership Application and Renewal Forms will be retained until replaced. The lists of GFGS membership will be kept for seven years. Your confidentiality is protected by the Data Protection Act and, from 25th May 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Regulation (EU) 2016/679) and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2016 (PECR).

Members

When you fill in a Membership Application or Membership Renewal form you are asked to provide GFGS with some personal data. We will also ask you to consent to the ways in which we may communicate with you. You may amend those consents at any time by contacting the GFGS Hon. Secretary.

Communication

We will use the data to provide the service that you expect as a result of your membership of GFGS and will communicate in the ways that you have agreed to. The data we hold will be used to send you notice of events, membership renewal and subscription information, reports, and notice of Annual and Extraordinary General Meetings.

Accessibility

GFGS will never share your information with other organisations, companies or charities for marketing or other purposes.

You have the right to object to the Information Commissioners Office (ICO) if you feel that GFGS is not handling your data in a satisfactory manner.

This is an Anglican church which is one of four churches in the Parish of Knaresborough and it serves the villages of Goldsborough, Flaxby and Coneythorpe.



Goldsborough & Flaxby Oil Co-operative purchasing agreement with Tate Oil

PRICE:

The Wholesale market price of oil is published daily by PLATTS. The price of your delivery will be the PLATTS published price, 24 hours prior to your delivery, plus 3.95 pence per litre. This is exactly the price formula we currently pay under our existing arrangements. Quoted price is subject to VAT.

FLEXIBLE ORDERING:

Order any time between January and November — this is to encourage Members to assist Tate by ordering outside their peak month, December. Orders placed during December for delivery before the end of the month, will be charged at the prevailing commercial price. Orders can be placed 24 hours a day / seven days a week via Tate's website www.tateoil.co.uk (the preferred method) or a dedicated order line 01943 854888 (working hours only)

IMPROVED DELIVERY TIME:

Orders will be delivered within ten working days. Emergency next working day deliveries can be made at an additional cost of £50+VAT.

ORDER VOLUME:

Orders can be for a fixed volume (minimum 500 litres to comply with Weights and Measures legislation) or "Fill tank" PLUS an estimated quantity required (this needs to be realistic: if more than 10% short, there is no guarantee the full amount will be delivered)

PAYMENT:

Payment will be by single Direct Debit payment approximately 14 days following delivery — a delivery note will be left on delivery and an invoice will be sent, preferably by e-mail for speed and to keep costs down. Debit cards and credit cards can be used by prior arrangement, but credit cards will attract a surcharge of 2% to offset bank charges.

NEW INFORMATION SERVICE:

Members requiring notification of delivery date will receive a text message to their mobile phone the previous day, so that gates and tanks can be left unlocked.

PRICE CHECKS:

Tate Fuels will provide a monthly summary to us of daily prices charged to Members under this agreement, and total volume delivered during the month, and extends an open invitation to the GFOco-op coordinator to audit the working of this agreement.

COMMUNICATION:

Only members of Goldsborough & Flaxby Oil Co-operative are eligible to purchase oil through this agreement. To ensure this, we will supply Tate Oil with all members contact details including email address. This will be stored confidentially by Tate Oil.
